NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARINGS

Pursuant to the provisions of Miscellaneous Rule No. 2 of the West Virginia Air Pollution Control Commission and the State Administrative Procedures Act, notice is hereby given that the Commission will hold public hearings on Tuesday, November 20, 1979, in Conference Rooms A and B of the Conference Center located at the State Capitol Complex, Charleston, West Virginia, concerning the following:

- (1) Miscellaneous Rule No. 3 pertaining to alternative programs, plans, or designs proposed by a source as provided for in Regulations XVII, XIX, XXI, XXIII, and XXIV which shall be embodied in Consent Orders and providing for notice thereof to the United States Environmental Protection Agency; and
- (2) Miscellaneous Rule No. 4 pertaining to the adoption of test procedures and providing for notice thereof to the United States Environmental Protection Agency.

These hearings will start immediately following the public hearings on proposed Regulation XIX and amendments to Regulation IX, which begin at 9:00.

Rule Number 3. Consent Orders.

Any alternative program, plan, or design proposed by a source as provided for in Regulations XVII, XIX, XXI, XXIII, and XXIV and approved by the Commission shall be embodied in a Consent Order pursuant to Chapter 16, Article 20, Section 5 (17) of the Code of West Virginia of 1931, as amended, and notice of entry of any such Consent Order shall be provided to the United States Environmental Protection Agency, Region III, not more than 30 days after entry for their review for inclusion in the State Implementation Plan.
