TITLE 47 LEGISLATIVE RULES

SERIES 11G WILD BOAR HUNTING REGULATIONS

§ 47-11G-1. General.

- 1.1. Scope and Purpose. -- The purpose of this regulation is to establish provisions to be complied with when in the pursuit of or taking of wild boar within the boundaries of this State.
 - 1.2. Authority. -- West Virginia Code § 20-1-7(30).
 - 1.3. Filing Date. --
 - 1.4. Effective Date. --

§ 47-11G-2. Definitions.

2.1. All terms shall have the meanings prescribed to them in the Code of State Regulations, Title 47, Series 11A (47 C.S.R. 11A).

§ 47-11G-3. Wild Boar Hunting Rules.

- 3.1. Provided that the hunter uses either a shotgun or a bow, the hunting of small game is permitted during the wild boar seasons in those counties, or portions thereof, designated by the commission as boar hunting areas. During this period a hunter may carry slugs and number 4 or smaller shot with a shotgun prior to killing a boar.
- 3.2. Boar may be legally taken during the firearms wild boar season with a bow or with a firearm using ammunition legal in West Virginia for the taking of deer.
- 3.3. No person may kill or wound a boar while the boar is in any stream, lake, or pond.
 - 3.4. The use of dogs to hunt wild boar is prohibited.
- 3.5. Applicants for a Class P license must be at least twelve (12) years of age.
- 3.6. Applicants for a Class P license must choose a license for either archery wild boar hunting or firearms wild boar hunting and may not apply for both.

- 3.7. Applicants for a Class P license for firearms wild boar hunting must choose a license for either the early firearms wild boar season or the late firearms wild boar season and may not apply for both.
- 3.8. Applications as prescribed by the director for a Class P firearms license must be complete and mailed prior to the deadline date on the application. Only one application may be submitted per individual.
- 3.9. A person killing a wild boar must, within twenty-four (24) hours, transport the boar to a conservation officer or an official game checking station in the County of kill for retagging.
