#### 45CSR16

#### SUMMARY

45CSR16 "Standards of Performance for New Stationary Sources" adopted by reference New Source Performance Standards (NSPS) promulgated by U. S. EPA through July 1, 1988. This revision to the rule updates NSPS requirements, with noted exceptions, through May 1, 1993.

42 U.S.C. 7411 [C.A.A. §111] charges the Administrator of U.S. EPA with developing standards for sources if the sources cause or contribute significantly to air pollution which may reasonably be anticipated to endanger public health or welfare. These standards are enforceable by U.S. EPA. In turn, the State may request delegation from U.S. EPA to implement and enforce such standards. To that end, Federal standards, as contained in the proposed rule, are adopted by reference.

The following subparts have been added to 40CFR60 since the previous revision of this rule.



applicable requirements up to this point under our rules and ask for EPA delegation of authority to enforce.

COMMISSIONER NEELY: What about sulfunic acid?

MR. FARLEY: There again, I would have to have Rick explain why that was excluded, but his instruction when he put this together was to exclude for sometion at this time any standard for which there was now issue associated with it in terms of lawsuits.

COMMISSIONER NEELy: And radon from anything having to do with the Department of Energy, it looks like.

MR. FARLEY: Anything that involves the enforcement of standards of radio activity, we have always excluded because EPA, up to this point anyway, has not encouraged any state to take those programs, and we don't feel we have the expertise or the facilities to handle radio active sources.

Rick, I would just ask in relation to the proposal to update Regulation 16 about the subsections that were excluded. Can you explain in each

of those cases. -- we are talking about emission guidelines for municipal waste combustors. Municipal waste combustors, I think those are kind of moot anyway, but we did exclude them.

• We also excluded subpart CB, emission guidelines for sulfuric acid production units.

Can you explain briefly why we excluded it?

MRT ADKINS: The municipal combustors, we talked with the people that are doing that at EPA in North Carolina and that particular reg is in total flux right now in litigation and other things, and they think it is going to be extensively changed.

They felt it would be reasonable not to include it at this point until it is sorted out.

MR. FARLEY: How about the sulfuric acid production units? Is that true --

MR. ADKINS: That is under the Section C and that had several things in it, and as far as we knew when we were talking about it, we do not have a sulfuric acid production unit.

MR. FARLEY: The way these standards work is EPA usually will strongly encourage the state to take the enforcement authority over a standard for which there are facilities covered in a state.

The state obviously — there are quite a number of things we have adopted or not adopted and more obviously that would never cover \*\* or does in the new cover any source that was a new source under those provisions.

There is a possibility that something within the state -- you know, if a facility would be proposed, it might be subject to these standards, but I don't think that would occur with municipality waste combustors. I am not sure about sulfuric acid production.

## COMMENTS OF WEST VIRGINIA MANUFACTURERS ASSOCIATION REGARDING PROPOSED APCC REGULATION 16 REVISIONS

## I. INTRODUCTION

On June 2, 1993, the West Virginia Air Pollution Control Commission ("APCC") filed with the Secretary of State a proposed legislative rule pertaining to "Standards of Performance for New Stationary Sources" as authorized under the West Virginia Air Pollution Control Act at Chapter 16, Article 20 of the West Virginia Code ("the Act"). The rule is proposed for inclusion in the Code of State Regulations at Title 45 Series 16.

The West Virginia Manufacturers Association ("WVMA") represents a broad cross-section of large, medium and small industrial concerns in West Virginia. Because certain of its members are subject to the Act, or indirectly affected by it, the WVMA has pledged to be involved in the development of these regulations. For example, many of our members operate facilities in West Virginia which will be directly impacted by these rules. It is in furtherance of our active and supportive role that the WVMA offers these comments.

## II. COMMENTS

The proposed rule at §45-16-3.1.b excludes "sub-parts B, C and Ea of 40 C.F.R. 60." The Summary of the regulation indicates that Subpart Ca - Emissions Guidelines for Municipal Waste Combusters, Subpart Cb - Emissions Guidelines for Sulfuric Acid Production Units, and Subpart Ea - Municipal Waste Combusters have been excluded. The WVMA assumes that the Summary of the

regulation indicating the exclusion of Subparts Ca, Cb and Ea is correct and that the apparent typographical error in the regulation which indicates that "Sub-parts B, C and Ea of 40 C.F.R. 60 ..." will be corrected in the final rule.

As a matter of policy, the WVMA encourages the adoption of performance standards which are consistent with both U.S. EPA and, to the extent possible, other states with which West Virginia competes in the area of economic development. It is imperative that all regulatory programs which affect businesses considering expansion in or relocating to West Virginia from other states impose a total regulatory impact on such businesses that provides an economic incentive to expand or relocate to West Virginia.

At the July 6, 1993, public hearing on the proposed APCC regulatory revision package, the OAQ staff indicated that the municipal waste combuster regulations were being excluded at the recommendation of U.S. EPA inasmuch as these subparts are the subject of ongoing litigation. The reason given for excluding the subpart on sulfuric acid production units apparently was that there are no such facilities in West Virginia. Until such time as the ongoing litigation is resolved, the WVMA is in agreement with the proposal to exclude the subparts related to municipal waste combusters. WVMA disagrees with the exclusion of the subpart on sulfuric acid production units on the basis that there are no such units currently in West Virginia.

The result of the proposed exclusion is that a sulfuric acid producer which may be evaluating locating in any of several states would be placed at a needless regulatory disadvantage in West Virginia because of the possibility of prolonged

permit application review proceedings. Such proceedings would be prolonged

because of the need for extensive interaction with U.S. EPA Region III in

establishing NSPS permit conditions since the WV APCC failed to adopt current

U.S. EPA standards in its latest regulatory revision.

Although this proposed regulatory revision would effectively exclude only

one subpart related to sulfuric acid production units, the WVMA suggests that it

should be the policy of the APCC in incorporating U.S. EPA new source

performance standards to include all such standards which have been

promulgated since the time of the last revision to the APCC regulation, provided

that the U.S. EPA standards are in full force and effect at the time of the

incorporation by APCC.

ш. CONCLUSION

In these comments, the WVMA offers its position on a key policy issue

presented by APCC's proposed new source performance standard revisions. Our

concern relates to the implementation of an efficient and fair regulatory program

for the comprehensive management of air quality in West Virginia.

## STAFF RESPONSE TO WVMA COMMENTS 45CSR16 JULY 22, 1993

COMMENT 1. WVMA notes that the proposed rule excludes "sub-parts B, C and Ea of 40 C.F.R.60." WVMA notes that the cited exclusions are different from the Summary of the proposed rule.

RESPONSE: The proposed exclusions differ from that contained in the proposed rule. 40 C.F.R.60 Subpart C, 40 C.F.R.60 Subpart Ca, and 40 C.F.R.60 Subpart Cb are distinct subparts and should be included separately in the list of exclusions. These subparts deal with guidelines, not standards, and OAQ believes the inclusion of such guidelines is inappropriate to the purpose of the rule.

COMMENT 2. WVMA disagrees with the exclusion of 40 C.F.R.60 Subpart Cb - "Emission Guidelines and Compliance Times for Sulfuric Acid Production Units." WVMA disagrees with the exclusion of this subpart based on the rationale that there are no such units currently in West Virginia. WVMA believes that new sulfuric acid production units might locate in other states if West Virginia did not have proper regulations governing such a facility.

RESPONSE: The provisions of subpart Cb were excluded because it does not provide standards, but merely guidelines. Further, the standards contained in 40 C.F.R.60 Subpart H - "Standards of Performance for Sulfuric Acid Plants" are in the current and proposed rules.
