NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

RE: The legislative rule proposed by the Board of Examiners of Registered Professional Nurses relating to requiring that, beginning in 1992, nurses obtain a baccalaureate degree as a minimum for licensure as a registered professional nurse

The Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee will conduct a public hearing on the proposed rule on Monday, November 18, 1985, from 1:00 - 3:00 p.m., in the House of Delegates Chamber of the State Capitol, Charleston, West Virginia. The hearing is being conducted to assist the Committee in its statutory duty to make a recommendation to the Legislature regarding whether or not the proposed rule should be approved by the Legislature.

A total of one hour will be allocated to the proponents and one hour will be allocated to the opponents. In order to make the most efficient use of the time allotted and to ensure that the Committee is made fully aware of all of the issues without unnecessary repetition, each side should designate one or more persons to present that side's opinions.

The Committee requests that persons wishing to speak at the hearing provide written copies of their statement.
