TITLE: WAIVER OF ELECTION FILING FEE - 1986

Section 1. General

1.1 Scope -- This legislative rule establishes the method for a waiver of the election filing fee for those candidates unable to pay such fee due to a lack of personal financial resources available to them.

1.2 Authority of Related Code -- West Virginia Code 3-1A-6; 3-5-8; 270 S.E. 2d 634; 318 S.E. 2d 622

1.3 Filing date -- December 30, 1985

1.4 Effective date -- December 30, 1985

Section 2. Waiver of Election Filing Fee

2.1 Any candidate may waive the election filing fee if the total annual individual income adjusted for the number of dependents is at or below the following income guidelines:

2.2 Determination of income shall be by completion of a financial affidavit prescribed by the Secretary of State and filled out and sworn to by the candidate and properly notarized.
