TITLE 153 PROCEDURAL RULES SECRETARY OF STATE

SERIES 21 DISPOSAL OF CANCELLED VOTER REGISTRATION DOCUMENTS

§153-21-1. General.

- 1.1. Scope. -- This rule provides for the disposal of voter registration documents that have been cancelled pursuant to the provisions of the West Virginia Code for purging voter registration records.
 - 1.2. Authority. -- W. Va. Code §3-1A-6
- 1.3. Filing Date. --
- 1.4. Effective Date. --

§153-21-2. Definitions.

2.1. "Voter registration documents" means the voter registration forms maintained by counties or

municipalities whose contents are provided for in §3-2-19 of the West Virginia Code.

2.2. "Cancellation" means the removal of voter registration forms from the records of the county and/or municipality pursuant to West Virginia Code §3-2-21, 22, 27 or 29.

§153-21-3. Disposal of cancelled registration forms.

3.1. Offices charged with keeping voter registration forms at the county or city level, who have cancelled these forms pursuant to the provisions of the West Virginia Code, may dispose of the cancelled voter registration forms any time after five (5) years of the date of their cancellation.
