14CSR5 Schedule of Fees Amendment

<u>Summary</u>

The amendment is written to add a fee for the Expanded Therapeutic Procedures Certificate proposed in new rule §14-12. It also adds ACH debit as a form of payment for fees.

- The fee added for an Expanded Therapeutic Procedures Certificate is \$200. This is the same as the fee as for the Oral Pharmaceutical Certificate and the Injectable Pharmaceutical Agents Certificate.
- The amendment officially adds the ACH debit method of payment to existing forms of payment listed in the rule. ACH debit is entered using the numbers from the bottom of a paper check. This service is available through the Board's web site and the WV State Treasurer's Office Egov system.

14CSR5 Schedule of Fees Amendment

<u>Circumstances</u>

The amendment adds a fee to fund the administrative costs for the Board's proposed rule, §14-12, Expanded Therapeutic Procedures. The fee is the same as for the Oral Pharmaceutical Certificate and the Injectable Pharmaceutical Agents Certificate. The amendment also officially adds ACH debit to the methods of payment accepted for fees already provided through the Board's web site and the WV State Treasurer's Office Egov system.

Fiscal Note Summary

This rule amendment makes two changes. It adds a fee to correspond with proposed rule §14-12 Expanded Therapeutic Procedures Certificate. The Board estimates that approximately 50 licensees will apply for an Expanded Therapeutic Procedures Certificate. It will take approximately 6 hours per applicant to set up policies, procedures, forms, process the applications, verify training, and set up systems for the record keeping portion of the rule. There will be associated current expense costs involved as well. The second change officially allows applicants, licensees and those who desire license verification to pay for services by ACH Debit in addition to check, money order, certified check and credit card. The additional payment method is available through the Board's web site and the WV State Treasurer's Egov system. The fee is the same as for a credit card, so there is no impact on costs to the Board.

With regard to section 14-5 "Schedule of Fees", it might have been a good idea to have made it more clear that this is a one time fee at the time of initial licensure and not a fee that is charged every 2 years with license renewal. If you could quote to the licensees the wording in Board of Medicine's rules that deal with this same thing, this may make OD's feel better about paying this. After the expanded scope we have fought for, none of us want to see us get the limited partial parity with medicine, only to find out the Board of Optometry feels we have no right to it without paying them an extra fee for it that the MD's don't pay too! I know you have worked hard to make sure this would never happen under your watch.



Dear Dr. Campbell,

The purpose of this letter is to provide comment on the proposed Legislative Rule by the Board of Optometry.

The West Virginia Academy of Family Physicians is concerned with the contents of Title 14, Series 12, relating to "Expanded Therapeutic Procedures Certificate."

The proposed rule does not follow the proper procedures as enacted in Senate Bill 214 during the 2012 Regular Legislative Session.

The new law requires any proposed scope of practice expansion to follow the "Sunrise Application Process" through the Legislature's Joint Committee of Government Organization and the Legislative Auditor's Office.

The proposed rule should be withdrawn and should not be considered by the Legislature's Rule Making Review Committee.

In addition, the corresponding proposed Legislative Rule **Title 14**, **Series 5**, relating to "Schedule of Fees for Expanded Therapeutic Procedures Certificate," should also be withdrawn as unnecessary.

§14-5 Schedule of Fees

Amendments

There were no new amendments to §14-5 as a result of the comments received. However, §14-12 was amended in §14-12-9.3 to clarify that the new \$200 fee for the Expanded Therapeutic Procedures Certificate is a one-time fee. Only the standard Annual Renewal fee will be charged upon recertification. It reads:

<u>"8.3.9.3.</u> The certificate holder shall submit the <u>recertification Annual Renewal</u> fee as listed in the W. Va. Code of Rules, §14-5."
