Regarding the program directors providing a signature on the application, in 19-3-3 subsection 3.1.a.3 the applicant shall be recommended to the board by the faculty of the school of nursing. This will be accomplished through a letter on the school's letterhead signed by the director.

Concerning the question if a record is expunged can the applicant can answer no – This is correct. If a record has been expunged the answer to having a conviction is no. The applicant must be certain there are documents that support the expungement.

Sue - since the board complied with the statutory notification requirements, the \$25 fee is permissible.

To explain the modification from 180 days to 90 days, you just need to say that the Board has been advised that board's rule regarding the 180 days is in conflict with the governing statute (which expressly provides that the temporary permit expires after 90 days), and the statute prevails over the rule.

Thank you for the opportunity to provide comments related to the proposed changes to WV19CSR3 Related to Licensure and Professional Misconduct. Knowing that the West Virginia Board of Examiners for Registered Professional Nurses is moving forward with joining the Nurse Licensure Compact, I offer that the Board considers adding language related to the electronic verification process that is part of Nursys, the National Council of State Boards of Nursing database. The proposed language is below:

19-3-11 The board, shall ~~furnish~~ provide a ~~certified statement verification~~ of West Virginia licensure upon submission of a written request by the licensee for the verification and payment of a fee set forth in the board's rule, §19 CSR 12, Fees. Should the board participate in the licensure verification system as maintained by the National Council of State Boards of Nursing, the licensee shall follow the process of endorsement to another state in accordance with the procedures set in place for that system. If the licensee is a graduate of a school which has closed and his or her records are on file in the board office, the board shall provide a copy of school records upon written request and payment of the fees set forth in the board's rule, Fees, 19 CSR 12.

Thank you in advance for your consideration of this change and for the continued work you do for public protection.
