West Virginia Fire Marshal Response to Comments of The Standards For The Certification And Continuing Education Of Municipal, County, And Other Public Sector Building Code Officials, Building Code Inspectors And Plans Examiners, 103-06

## **BACKGROUND**

The Fire Marshal has been given authority to promulgate this Rule, pursuant to a statutory shift passed in 58 586, during the 2020 legislative session. The Marshal is proposing a revision to the rule, to bring the rule into compliance with newly passed legislation, in HB 4308, and to perform technical clean up pursuant to 588 586.

Prior to the Marshal's initial filing of the Rule, a stakeholder meeting was held at the Office of the State Fire Marshal, via teleconference on May 17, 2020, and on June 11, 2020, and, along with members of the Office of the State Fire Marshal, the lists of attendees is attached as addendum 1 to this document. The proposed rule was reviewed, and revisions made, prior to the initial filing with the Secretary of State for comment.

During the public comment period, the Fire Marshal received written comments from one entity, each was considered by the Marshal. The response is outlined as follows:

 The Home Builders Association of West Virginia requests that field experience be required of journeyman electricians to be allowed to perform electrical inspections in one and two family dwellings.

Answer: The Marshal has amended the rule in section 3.1.b.4.

Technical clean-up was made to the Rule.

This summarizes the topics upon which comments were made to the West Virginia State Fire Marshal on the topic of the proposed rule, The Standards For The Certification And Continuing Education Of Municipal, County, And Other Public Sector Building Code Officials, Building Code Inspectors And Plans Examiners, 103-06.
