RE: Minimum Licensing Requirements for Residential Child Care and Treatment Facilities for Children and Transitioning Adults in West Virginia
W. Va. C.S.R. § 78-3

The Bureau for Children and Families of the Department of Health and Human Resources requests that W. Va. C.S.R. § 78-3 be temporarily suspended in part effective immediately pursuant to W. Va. Code §15-5-6(c)(7) and the State of Emergency declared by Governor Justice on March 16, 2020.

W. Va. C.S.R. § 78-3 establishes and sets forth the requirements for residential child care and treatment facilities for children and transitioning adults. Strict compliance with the following paragraph will hinder and delay necessary action in coping with the emergency declared by the Governor in so far as this provision require in-person visitation between children and families:

W. Va. C.S.R. § 78-3.5.4.1.h.

If granted, the Bureau for Children and Families further requests that the rule be suspended until such time as the State of Emergency is lifted.

This memorandum supersedes all other such memoranda. Except as stated herein, all other regulations previously suspended are now in full force and effect.
