WHEREAS, more than 160 CSR rules have been repealed as a result of recent regulatory reform efforts;

WHEREAS, continuing to reduce the heavy regulatory burden on West Virginians created by the CSR will promote citizens' freedom to readily engage in individual, family and business pursuits;

WHEREAS, these business pursuits are critical to economic growth and job creation in a dynamic economy;

WHEREAS, necessary burdensome CSR rules: (1) stifle economic growth and job creation; (2) create barriers to entry in many industries and (3) discourage potential entrepreneurs from introducing beneficial products and processes;

WHEREAS, when promulgating and modifying CSR rules, it is important that state agencies consider the impact on economic growth and job creation for West Virginia and its citizens;

WHEREAS, Article VII, Section 2 of the West Virginia Constitution vests the executive power of the State of West Virginia in the Governor;

WHEREAS, the Governor's executive power may be exercised through Executive Orders; and

WHEREAS, an administrative rule-making instrument known as a "Regulatory Memorandum" established by this Executive Order will be an important part of the regulatory reform efforts by this administration;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, JIM JUSTICE, by the authority vested in me as the Governor of the State of West Virginia, do hereby ORDER that:

1. This action shall be known as the "Regulatory Memorandum".
2. All agencies shall request rule-making advice on any proposed rules that have not been filed with the Secretary of State's office on or before the date this Regulatory Memorandum Executive Order becomes effective.
3. Rules pending in the following areas shall be rescinded from this Regulatory Memorandum:

- (a) Legislative excepted rules enumerated in West Virginia Code §20A-1-3;
- (b) Interstate rules as defined in West Virginia Code §20A-1-2(d);
- (c) Procedural rules as defined in West Virginia Code §20A-1-2(c);
- (d) Emergency rules meeting the requirements of West Virginia Code §20A-1-3(d);
- (e) Amending state rules to be no more stringent than federal rules;
- (f) Implementing a federal mandate and so where it is permitted;
- (g) Updating state rules to comply with federal law requirements;
- (h) Necessary to avoid violation of a court order;
- (i) New rules promulgated as a result of legislation enacted after the effective date of this Regulatory Memorandum Executive Order;
- (j) Matters pertaining to the control, regulation or restriction of water, land or other public or state agency;
- (k) Job creation;
- (l) Increasing investment in West Virginia.

8. This Regulatory Memorandum Executive Order shall remain in effect until expressly modified or superseded by a subsequent Executive Order.
