days. In an election year, the report may be called the "first" report for candidates who plan to run in the primary election. The first general reporting period begins on the last Saturday in September and continues for 15 days.	
Candidates who do not have to file a financial report may instead file a Statement of Waiver. This Statement of Waiver tells the public and press that the candidate is not required to file a financial report.	
NOTE: THE STATEMENT OF WAIVER CANNOT BE FILED IN PLACE OF ANY PRE-PRIMARY, POST-PRIMARY, PRE-GENERAL, OR POST-GENERAL ELECTION REPORT.
