Judy, OIC withdraws its filing of the proposed emergency rule amending 114 CSR 25 "Adjusters." When we filed the proposal, we were under the impression that the federal government might require compliance with the new crop adjuster certification requirements in the upcoming year. However, according to the recently released Standard Reinsurance Agreement, it appears that a state such as WV, which requires a licensing test for persons adjusting crop losses, has until the beginning of the 2012 reinsurance year to require that the new federal proficiency standards be met as a condition of licensure. We are checking with the federal agency but we do not feel that the emergency is justified at this time. .
