


NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

The purpose of this Public Hearing is to hear data, objections, suggested amendments, views, evidence and arguments pertaining to proposed rules and regulations of the Department of Labor designated Chapter twenty-one, Article three, Section seven of the Code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended.

All interested persons may submit such data, objections, suggested amendments, views, evidence or arguments on that date or in writing at any time prior to the scheduled hearing. The issues to be heard shall be limited to the scope of the proposed fees (1) for the inspection of boilers by those whom the Commissioner of Labor has authorized as inspectors, (2) for the processing of inspection reports from insurance companies, (3) for issuing annual permits to operate boilers, and (4) for commissioning insurance company boiler inspectors.

Subject: Rules and Regulations for the inspection
of steam boilers.

Section 1. General.

1.01. Scope. The Department of Labor establishes fees (1) for the inspection of boilers by those whom the Commissioner of Labor has authorized as inspectors, (2) for the processing of inspection reports from insurance companies, (3) for issuing annual permits to operate boilers, and (4) for commissioning insurance company boiler inspectors.

1.02. Authority. Section 7, Article 3, Chapter 21, as amended by the 1982 Legislature and passed March 8, 1982.

1.03. Effective Date. These inspection rates are promulgated on the _____ day of _____, 1982, and become effective on the _____ day of _____, 1982.

1.04. General Purposes. The general purpose of these rules and regulations is to formulate an inspection fee schedule. These rules and regulations establish fees:

(1) for the inspection of boilers by those whom the Commissioner of Labor has authorized as inspectors,

(2) for the processing of inspection reports from insurance companies,

(3) for issuing annual permits to operate boilers, and

(4) for commissioning insurance company boiler inspectors.

WEST VIRGINIA DEPARTMENT OF LABOR

2.01. ALL fee charges shall be paid before issuing annual permits to operate a boiler. Checks and money orders for payment of all fees shall be made payable to the West Virginia Department of Labor.
