The Committee amended the proposed rule on page 18, subsection 15.4 by deleting the following proviso: "Provided, however: When the balance of the Recovery Fund reaches a balance of one-million dollars or more, the interest revenues shall be deposited in the Manufactured Housing special revenue account to be used by the division of labor for routine enforcement purposes".

The Committee found that the expenditures provided for do not follow the expenditures provided for in the Code.
