


Dear Mr. Hartman:

Senate Bill No. 378

(By Senator Tucker)

[Introduced February 5, 1987; referred to the Committee
on HEALTH AND HUMAN RESOURCES ; then to
the Committee on the Judiciary.]

A BILL to amend article two, chapter sixty-four of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, by adding thereto a new section designated section thirty (seven-a)(five) relating to authorizing the West Virginia board of examiners for licensed practical nurses to promulgate legislative rules governing fees for services rendered by the board.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That article two, chapter sixty-two of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new section, designated section thirty (seven-a)(five), to read as follows:

ARTICLE 2. EXECUTIVE AGENCY AUTHORIZATION TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.

§64-2-30(7a)(5). West Virginia board of examiners for licensed practical nurses.

1 The legislative rules filed in the state register on the
2 thirtieth day of July, one thousand nine hundred eighty-six,
3 relating to the West Virginia board of examiners for licensed
4 practical nurses (fees for services rendered by the board) are
5 authorized.
