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SUMMARY OF CONTENT OF LEGISLATIVE RULE

This rule raises fees for application and biennial registration of medical and podiatric corporations. The amounts are equal to or less than the amounts authorized by statute (West Virginia Code §30-3-15).

The rule raises fees for inactive licensure renewal to one half that of fees for active licensure renewals, in order to attempt to recoup the costs to the Board of processing these inactive renewal forms.

The rule raises the fees for giving the podiatric examination to recoup the costs to the Board of giving the podiatric examination.

Finally, because of the amount of time spent in verifying physician or podiatrist licensure in West Virginia, the rule provides for a nominal fee to be charged for such written verification.
