**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO REGULATION VII
"To Prevent and Control Particulate Air Pollution
From Manufacturing Process Operations"**

FISCAL NOTE

I. PURPOSE:

Amendments to Regulation VII will bring the regulation into compliance with US EPA requirements and allow the State of West Virginia to have an approvable State Implementation Plan by US EPA. Regulation VII also establishes emission limitations for new coking facilities which must meet best available control technology according to the Federal Clean Air Act.

II. COST:

- (1) The cost to the industrial plants in West Virginia would be minimal because these plants already have to meet similar US EPA requirements for the same sources.
- (2) Cost to the APCC is insignificant because this is part of the agency's overall activities. No new personnel positions are necessary to implement these amendments to Regulation VII.


