BONDING REQUIREMENTS FOR
LICENSE SERVICE AGENCIES**

§91-10-1. General.

1.1. Scope. -- These legislative rules establish the procedures by which checks tendered by persons in the business of assisting the general public in processing motor vehicle documents may be accepted by the Department of Motor Vehicles.

§91-10-2. Application And Enforcement.

2.1. Application -- These legislative rules apply to persons in the business of assisting the general public in processing motor vehicle documents.

2.2. Enforcement -- Enforcement of these legislative rules is vested with the Commissioner of Motor Vehicles.

§91-10-3. License Services, Etc.

3.1. It is recognized that many persons, firms associations, clubs and corporations are engaged in the regular daily business of registering and titling motor vehicles and obtaining Operator's and Chauffeur's Licenses and motor vehicle registration license plates for the general public. Checks tendered to the Department by any such person, firm, association, club or corporation in payment of registration, title, license and other fees and/or taxes will not be accepted unless prior thereto such person, firm association, club or corporation has entered into a bond with the State of West Virginia with a corporate surety licensed to do business in the State of West Virginia by the Insurance Commissioner, conditioned upon the payment of all such checks upon presentation to the bank upon which the same are drawn and conditioned upon saving the State of West Virginia harmless from any and all liability and loss by reason of the acceptance of such checks and the issuance of license or registration plates, etc., in return therefor.
