Dear Secretary Heiskell:

In accordance with the provisions of 29A-3-5 and 29A-3-2, Code of West Virginia; and by authority vested in the Director of the Department of Natural Resources under 20-1-7 (30), the enclosed regulations are hereby declared effective April 1, 1973.

This emergency action is necessary due to extreme law enforcement problems being encountered on the public areas in question. The unusual springlike weather has caused heavy usage of the areas by young people who, if permitted to consume beer, become unruly and troublesome. This regulation is needed immediately in order to preserve public peace and safety.

In compliance with the Code, notice has been placed in newspapers located in the immediate area of the facilities. Also, such regulations have been filed with your office, to become permanent after the thirty-day period.

Section 2. Special Regulations

2.01. Stonecoal Public Hunting and Fishing Area--

(a) It is unlawful to create any shoreline developments of any kind on lands and waters under control of the Department of Natural Resources on the Stonecoal Public Hunting and Fishing area.

(b) All motorboats used on the reservoir are limited to a maximum of 10 H.P. No wake zones will be maintained with buoys.

(c) It is unlawful to water ski on this public hunting and fishing area.

2.02. Leachtown Fisherman Access Site--No liquor, wine, beer or other alcoholic beverages permitted upon this facility.

2.03. Kanawha State Forest--No beer, liquor, wine, or other alcoholic beverages permitted within the boundaries of Kanawha State Forest.

2.04. Chief Logan State Park--No beer, liquor, wine, or other alcoholic beverages permitted within the boundaries of Chief Logan State Park.

2.05. Tomlinson Run State Park--No beer, liquor, wine, or other alcoholic beverages permitted within the boundaries of Tomlinson Run State Park.
