Section 2. Special Regulations

2.01. Stonecoal Public Hunting and Fishing Area--

(a) It is unlawful to create any shoreline developments of any kind on lands and waters under control of the Department of Natural Resources on the Stonecoal Public Hunting and Fish-  
ing area.

(b) All motorboats used on the reservoir are limited to a maximum of 10 H.P. No wake zones will be maintained with buoys.

(c) It is unlawful to water ski on this public hunting and fishing area.

2.02. Leachtown Fisherman Access Site--No liquor, wine, beer or other alcoholic beverages permitted upon this facility.
