Section 2, Paragraph 12, Special Regulations

No explosive materials or other dangerous substances are permitted.

Uncased firearms and broad-head arrows are prohibited other than when the area is open for hunting or when registered park or forest guests have the written permission of the superintendent to carry uncased firearms or broad-head arrows from lodge, er cabin or campground to open hunting areas.

Section 2, Paragraph 18, Special Regulations

No person shall may operate a-snowmobile any vehicle in a manner so as to harass, chase, or annoy any animals or birds.
