These regulations are being filed on an emergency basis, effective May 8, 1984, to be effective for 180 days or until such date as legislative approval is received of the permanent regulations.

These regulations are filed in accordance with the provisions of House Bill 1025, passed February 8, 1984; in effect ninety days from passage.

There would be no fiscal impact to the department or holders of the Class A-1 Small Arms Hunting License as a result of these regulations, therefore, no fiscal note will be submitted..
