Dear Secretary Rockefeller:

By virtue of the powers and authority granted to the Director of the Department of Natural Resources by Article 1, Section 7, Chapter 20, Code of West Virginia, the following changes in Administrative Regulations 20-1, Series IV, 1972-73 Hunting and Trapping Regulations are hereby made.

Section 5, paragraph 09 (5.09) dealing with "Bag and possession limits for raccoon," is hereby rescinded in its entirety and changed to read: "Bag limit during any 11-hour period beginning at 6:00 p.m. and ending at 5:00 a.m. is four raccoons for one person or group of persons as a party and 40 per season in the following counties: Jefferson, Berkeley, Morgan, Hampshire, Hardy, Mineral, Grant, and Pendleton. Bag limit during any 11-hour period beginning at 6:00 p.m. and ending at 5:00 a.m. is two raccoons for one person or group of persons as a party and 20 per season for the remainder of the state."

Section 6, paragraph 07 (6.07) dealing with "Having a strung bow in your possession or control while in or on any vehicle, conveyance or their attachments within this state," is hereby rescinded and is to be deleted from the current Administrative Regulations 20-1, Series IV.
