Dear Secretary Manchin:

After an assessment of the projected harvest of antlerless deer in the Eastern Panhandle during the upcoming December 11 and 12 Special Antlerless Deer Hunting Season, I have determined that it is necessary to extend the season beyond the 2-day period in order to accomplish a higher harvest of antlerless deer. I have, therefore, by the attached Order, extended the scheduled antlerless deer season for two additional days, December 14-15, in the following counties or parts of counties open for antlerless deer hunting: Pendleton, Hampshire, Hardy, and Mineral. This extension of the Special Antlerless Deer Hunting Season will be limited to private lands only in these counties.

This action is being taken to accomplish a desired harvest of antlerless deer to alleviate excessive crop damage caused by the heavy concentration of deer in these counties.
