INSTRUCTIONS

1. The 1974 antlerless deer season will be open to West Virginia residents only.
2. The season dates will be Friday and Saturday, December 13-14, 1974.
3. The application must be filled out completely and signed. Missing information will disqualify the applicant.
4. Six counties will be open during the antlerless deer season, and a permit allows the holder to hunt in **only one** of these counties. A separate random selection will be made for each county. All applicants checking a given county in Item 3 on the reverse side will be included in the drawing for that county. All selections will be made at random by computer.
5. If fewer applications are received for one county than the number of permits to be issued, all applicants indicating that they are willing to hunt in any county (Item 4 on reverse side) will be included in a second drawing for the remaining permits for that county.
6. Successful applicants will be sent a Notice of Eligibility in October 1974. This Notice will indicate the county in which the applicant may hunt. Instructions on the Notice will tell the applicant what to do in order to receive his Antlerless Deer License.
7. A \$5.00 fee will be required from each successful applicant. The fee should be sent in **after** the Notice of Eligibility is received. **Do not send any money with this application.**
8. This application must be received in our office no later than July 31, 1974. Applications received after July 31 will not be included in the drawing. Mail application to:

(g) To have the .22 caliber pistol or revolver loaded when not actually hunting.

Section 13. Class N Special Deer Hunting License:

13.01. These regulations will supercede all conflicting hunting regulations previously published for 1974.

13.02. The antlerless deer season will be December 13-14, 1974 inclusive.

13.03. Bag limit will be one antlerless deer per day, one per season. This is in addition to the bag limit in the published regulations.

13.04. No deer with an antler over 3 inches, as measured from the hairline, shall be legal.

13.05. Counties open to antlerless deer hunting on December 13-14 are Hampshire, Hardy, Tucker, Pendleton, Grant and Mineral. Hunting for any other species on December 13-14, 1974 in counties having an antlerless season will be illegal.

13.06. Only West Virginia residents will be eligible to apply for a Class N license.

13.07. All applications for antlerless deer licenses shall:

(a) be on the prescribed Department form.

(b) be received in the Department of Natural Resources office at Elkins no later than July 31, 1974 to be eligible.

(c) be filled out completely and signed. Incomplete applications will be voided.
