Section 2. Daily Creel Limits and Possession Limits

2.01. Black Bass--(Smallmouth, Largemouth, Spotted)--Daily creel limit is 8. Possession limit is 16 bass in the aggregate.

(a) Special Regulation for Charles Fork Lake, Roane County, only--
Daily creel limit is 2.

2.02. Trout--(Rainbow, Brook, Brown, Golden Rainbow)--Daily creel limit is 6, including U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Lakes; only 4 of the 6 may be taken from small impoundments stocked with trout, Edwards Run, Otter Creek, and the following streams: Big Huff Creek, Wyoming and Logan Counties; Big Sandy Creek, Preston County; Clear Fork, McDowell County; Cross Creek, Brooke County; East Lynn (Tailwaters), Wayne County; Grave Creek, Marshall County; Kings Creek, Hancock County; Marsh Fork, Raleigh County; North Fork Dam and South Fork Fishing Creek, Wetzel County; Paint Creek, Fayette County; Panther Creek, McDowell County; Paw-Paw Creek, Marion County; Spruce Laurel Fork, Boone County; Tomlinson Run, Hancock County; West Fork Twelvepole, Wayne County; Wheeling Creek, Marshall County; and, Wickwire Creek, Taylor County. Possession limit is 12.

Daily creel limit on Catch and Release Areas--One. Possession limit--One. (See Sections 4.01 and 4.02.)

Daily creel limit on Fly Fishing Only Streams--None. Possession limit--None. (See Sections 4.03, 4.04, and 4.05.)

(a) Only one line per angler will be permitted during period January 1 through June 15 while fishing for trout in small impoundments stocked with trout. Does not apply to U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Lakes.
