

Dear Mr. Hechler:

The Department of Natural Resources has received numerous requests seeking an extension of the public comment period for its proposed Solid Waste Management Regulations (Title 47, Series 38). This proposed legislative rule was filed with your office on November 4, 1988 with a comment period set to end on Friday, December 16, 1988. The proposed regulations are both lengthy and complex; therefore, to assure that sufficient time is provided to all commenters, the Department requests that the comment period be extended until 4:00 p.m. on Friday, December 30, 1988.

Due to the high level of interest in the proposed rules, the Department is changing the location of the public hearing on the rules in order to accommodate a larger attendance. The hearing will still be held on Thursday, December 15, 1988 as originally scheduled but the hearing will now be held in the North Conference Room of the Cultural Center, State Capitol Complex, Charleston. In order to allow people arriving at the previously-scheduled hearing room to move to this new location, the hearing will begin at 1:30 p.m., one-half hour later than originally scheduled.
