- (2) For fuel burning units of the Mitchell Plant of Ohio Power Company, located in Air Quality Control Region I, the product of 7.5 and the total design heat inputs for such units discharging through those stacks in million British Thermal Units (B. T. U. 's) per hour.
- ~~(2)~~ (3) For fuel burning units of the Willow Island Station of Monongahela Power Company, located in Air Quality Control Region II, the product of ~~6.0~~ 2.7 and the total design heat inputs for such units discharging from those stacks in million B. T. U. 's per hour.
- ~~(3)~~ For all other Type 'a' fuel burning units, the product of ~~2.7~~ and the total design heat inputs for such units discharging through those stacks in million B. T. U. 's per hour.
- (4) For Type 'b' and Type 'c' fuel burning units, the product of 3.1 and the total design heat inputs for such units discharging through those stacks in million B. T. U. 's per hour.

3.02. Maximum Allowable Emission Rates for Similar Units in Region IV (Kanawha Valley Air Quality Control Region: Kanawha County, Putnam County, and Falls and Kanawha Magisterial Districts of Fayette County).

No person shall cause, suffer, allow, or permit the discharge of sulfur dioxide into the open air from all stacks located at one plant, measured in terms of pounds per hour, in excess of the amount determined as follows:
