Dear Mr. Secretary:

In accordance with the provisions of 29A-3-5 and 29A-3-2, Code of West Virginia; and by authority vested in the Director of the Department of Natural Resources under 20-1-7 (30), the enclosed regulations are hereby declared effective March 8, 1976.

This emergency action is necessary due to extreme law enforcement problems being encountered on the public areas in question. The unusual springlike weather has caused heavy usage of the areas by young people who, if permitted to consume beer, etc., become unruly and troublesome. This regulation is needed immediately in order to preserve public peace and safety.

In compliance with the Code, notice has been placed in newspapers located in the immediate area of the facilities. Also, such regulations have been filed with your office, to become permanent after the thirty-day period.
