

Statement of Facts Which Constitute The Emergency

In accordance with the provisions of 20-1-7, Code of West Virginia; and by authority vested in the Director of the Department of Natural Resources, the enclosed regulations are hereby declared effective August 17, 1977.

This emergency action is necessary due to extreme law enforcement problems being encountered on the public areas in question. The unusual summer weather has caused heavy usage of the areas by young people who, if permitted to consume beer, become unruly and troublesome.

This regulation is needed immediately in order to preserve public peace and safety.
