PROPOSED RULE: *Special Fishing Rule (58CSR61)*

The Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee recommends that the West Virginia Legislature:

- 1. Authorize the agency to promulgate the Legislative Rule

- 2. Authorize the agency to promulgate part of the Legislative rule; a statement of reasons for such recommendation is attached.
- 3. Authorize the agency to promulgate the Legislative rule with certain amendments; amendments and a statement of reasons for such recommendation is attached.
- 4. Authorize the agency to promulgate the Legislative rule as modified with certain amendments; amendments and a statement of reasons for such recommendation is attached.
- 5. Recommends that the rule be withdrawn; a statement of reasons for such recommendation is attached.

ABSTRACT

The proposed rule amends a current legislative rule. The amendment would allow an angler fishing in impoundments stocked with trout by the Division from January 1 through May 31 to have only two poles or lines.

It also added Millers Fork Pond to the list of bodies of water open for a special fishing season for Class Q licensees.

AUTHORITY

Statutory authority: W.Va. Code, §20-1-7, which provides, in part, as follows:

In addition to all other powers, duties and responsibilities granted and assigned to the director in this chapter and elsewhere by law, the director is hereby authorized and empowered to:

...(30) Promulgate rules, in accordance with the provisions of chapter twenty-nine-a of this code, to implement and make effective the powers and duties vested in him or her by the provisions of this chapter and take such other steps as may be necessary in his or her discretion for the proper

and effective enforcement of the provisions of this chapter
