


NOTICE OF HEARING FOR PROPOSED RULES

Pursuant to Chapter 29A, Article 3, of the West Virginia Code of 1931 as amended, the West Virginia State Board of Registration for Professional Engineers shall convene a public hearing at 9:00 A.M. on Tuesday, October 20, 1981 at 608 Union Building, Charleston, West Virginia for the purpose of taking evidence to the Rules and Regulations as follows:

1. EIT to be deleted and EI inserted to stand for Engineer Intern
2. Change of designation of location for examination schedule
3. Branch of engineering will be deleted from the roster
4. Eliminate a fixed passing grade
5. Graduates of Board approved allied science curricula may be admitted to the Fundamentals of Engineering examination upon presentation of evidence of two years of engineering experience under the direct supervision of a Professional Engineer and may be certified as an EI upon successful completion of the examination.

These graduates will be admitted to the examination in the Principles and Practice of Engineering after they have completed an additional four years of engineering practice under the supervision of registered Professional Engineers who can attest to the engineering nature of the work.

All persons desiring to present evidence on the proposed modification of the rules and regulations shall be present in person at the hearing. The issues to be discussed at the hearing will be limited to actual information contained in the proposed modification of the rules and regulations as set out above. All evidence offered for the Board's consideration with reference to the proposed modification of the rules and regulations shall be submitted in written form and delivered to the Office of the West Virginia State Board of Registration for Professional Engineers, 608 Union Building, Charleston, West Virginia 25301, on or before 4:00 P.M. on Monday, October 19, 1981.
