

NOTICE OF HEARING  
FOR PROPOSED RULES

Pursuant to Chapter 29A, Article 3, of the West Virginia Code of 1931, as amended, the West Virginia State Board of Registration for Professional Engineers shall convene a public hearing at 10:00 a.m. on Wednesday, September 19, 1979, at 608 Union Building, Charleston, West Virginia, for the purpose of taking evidence pertaining to the existing Rules and Regulations for:

1. Repeal of the portion pertaining to Prohibition against Competitive Bidding, known as Section 8 E (2) under Disciplinary Proceedings;
2. Modification of Section 4.05 by deleting "the enumerated branches of engineering for examinations" and inserting "examinations will be given in those branches in which examinations are prepared by the National Council of Engineering Examiners";
3. To modify Sections 2.02 and 3.02 by changing the name of "Engineer in Training" to "Engineer Intern".

All persons desiring to present evidence on the proposed repeal and modification of the rules and regulations shall be present in person at the hearing. The issues to be discussed at the hearing will be limited to actual information contained in the proposed repeal and modification of the rules and regulations as set out above. All evidence offered for the Board's consideration with reference to the proposed repeal and modification of the rules and regulations shall be submitted in written form and delivered to the Office of the West Virginia State Board of Registration for Professional Engineers, 608 Union Building, Charleston, West Virginia 25301, on or before 4:30 p.m. on Tuesday, September 18, 1979.
