Dear Mr. Manchin:

This is notification of approval of rules and regulations in accordance with Section 11, Article 3, Chapter 29A of the West Virginia Code.

On May 7, 1979, the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee approved regulations submitted by the Medical Licensing Board on physicians assistants and on mobile intensive care paramedics; by the Board of Investments on administration of the consolidated fund; by the State Board of Examiners of Land Surveyors; by the Department of Employment Security on secrecy of tax information; by the Department of Agriculture on equine infectious anemia and restricted use pesticides; and by the Water Development Authority on amended requirements governing disbursement of loans and grants to governmental agencies for the acquisition or construction of water development projects.

Two sets of regulations were withdrawn by the submitting agencies. These regulations were the Department of Mines' regulations concerning standards for coal mine underground electricians and the Board of Investments' regulations concerning selection of state depositories for demand deposits through competitive bidding.

A copy of the approved regulations and the withdrawn regulations is attached.

NOTICE OF REPEAL OF REGULATION 7.08 OF THE WEST VIRGINIA
STATE BOARD OF EXAMINERS OF LAND SURVEYORS

WHEREAS, on December 15, 1978, a notice of a public meeting on January 20, 1979, to repeal regulation 7.08 of the State Board of Examiners of Land Surveyors, was sent to the Governor, the Secretary of State, the Attorney General, and the Legislative Rule-Making Committee, said regulation being as follows (under Unethical Practices): "Advertising in any self-laudatory manner derogatory to the dignity of land surveying," and

WHEREAS, a notice of said hearing was also published in the Inter-Mountain newspaper at Elkins, West Virginia on January 17, 1979, and

WHEREAS, said hearing was held as publicized, and

WHEREAS, John Campbell, ILS, 102 First Street, Parsons, W.Va., was present in behalf of the West Virginia Association of Land Surveyors, Box 125, Charleston, West Virginia 25321, and presented verbally a substitute for regulation 7.08 as follows: "Surveyors may advertise, but not in any self-laudatory manner derogatory to the dignity of land surveying," and

WHEREAS, the Attorney General of West Virginia has recommended that said regulation 7.08 be repealed, and

WHEREAS, no other statements verbally or in writing having been received,

NOW THEREFORE, the Board having considered the evidence, Sipe moved that regulation 7.08 be repealed. Holt seconded the motion, and it was passed unanimously. Chairman Stiles therefore declared regulation 7.08 repealed and requested that 17 copies be sent to the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee.

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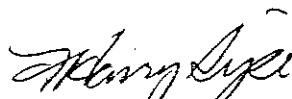
