

17-1-2. Summary of fees.

2.1. The following fees were approved by the West Virginia Legislature effective February 29, 1972:

2.1a. Application fee (whether by standard procedure, reciprocity or verification by American Board of Examiners in Professional Psychology diploma):  
~~Fifty dollars (\$50.00)~~  
Ninety-five dollars (\$95.00)

2.1b. Temporary permits: Fifty dollars (\$50.00)

2.1c. License renewal fee (every two (2) years):  
~~Thirty dollars (\$30.00)~~  
Sixty dollars (\$60.00)

2.1d. Registers: ~~Two~~<sup>Ten</sup> dollars ~~(\$2.00)~~<sup>(\$10.00)</sup>

2.2. The following fee was approved by the West Virginia Legislature effective February 12, 1985:

2.2a. Examination fee: The fee for the Examination for Professional Practice in Psychology will cover the fee established by the American Association of State Psychology Boards plus twenty dollars (\$20.00) for administrative costs. The fee must be paid to the Board at least thirty (30) days prior to the date of the examination.

2.3. All of the above fees are nonrefundable.

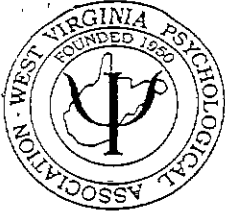

Dear Jeff:

As I indicated to you during our recent phone conversation, I have no difficulty with the increase in fees as outlined in your letter of July 14, 1988. I understand that this is a cumbersome project to have the fees increased but I would suggest that the Board consider re-evaluating the fees every 2-3 years so that the increase is not, at first glance, so substantial. Certainly the change of the fees represents nearly a 100% increase in total but I think the fact that the fees have not changed for 16 years will be lost on a lot of people. Therefore, I suggest a regular schedule for reevaluation.

Also, as I mentioned to you, I would like to see an increase in the CEU requirement. This is something that has been discussed for a number of years in the Executive Committee of WVPA and one which I think has substantial support. It is, in my opinion, somewhat of an embarrassment that it only takes 10 CEUs in a two year period to validate one's license. I don't have any recommendation as to the increase for this but I do recommend that an increase be considered. If I or WVPA may be of assistance to the Board in this regard, please let me know.

Jeff, as a reminder, please submit to Terry Roach a listing of all your Board members with addresses and phone numbers as well as your listing of your chairs, similar to that listed on the bottom of your stationary. This information will be passed on to our membership in their registration packets. I would like you to date this information as well so we know how old the information is and also to update it as indicated. Thanks for this - a lot of people were interested in it at the last meeting.
