

NOTICE OF EXTENSION OF PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD

The West Virginia Division of Environmental Protection, Office of Air Quality, hereby provides notice of the extension of the public comment period previously established for proposed revisions to the following legislative rules:

- 45CSR1 "NO_x Budget Trading Program as a Means of Control and Reduction of Nitrogen Oxides" (New Rule)
- 45CSR15 "Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants Pursuant to 45 CFR Part 61"
- 45CSR16 "Standards of Performance for New Stationary Sources Pursuant to 40 CFR Part 60"
- 45CSR34 "Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants for Source Categories Pursuant to 40 CFR Part 63"

Upon authorization and promulgation of new 45CSR1, the rule will be submitted to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency for its approval as part of the State Implementation Plan pursuant to the Clean Air Act.

Upon authorization and promulgation of revisions to 45CSR15, 45CSR16 and 45CSR34, the Office of Air Quality will seek federal delegation of authority from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency to implement and enforce the revised standards.

The public comment period, previously set to expire at the close of the public hearing on August 14, 2000 will be extended up to and including August 21, 2000, at 5:00 p.m. to permit the receipt of written comments which will be made a part of the rule-making record. The public hearing set for August 14, 2000, at 6:00 p.m. will be held as previously noticed.
