SECTION 13. OPTIONAL LIFE.

13.01. Employee Participation

(a) The board shall make available to member employees, at full cost to the employee, the opportunity to purchase optional group life and accidental death insurance in an amount not to exceed fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) for life insurance and fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) for accidental death insurance.

(b) The board shall also make available to member employees, at full cost to the employee, the opportunity to purchase said optional coverage for the employee's spouse and dependents, in an amount not to exceed five thousand dollars (\$5,000) for life insurance and five thousand dollars (\$5,000) for accidental death insurance for the spouse and not to exceed two thousand dollars (\$2,000) in life insurance and two thousand dollars (\$2,000) in accidental death insurance for each eligible dependent.

(c) The term "dependents" shall mean the same as defined in Section 2 of these rules.
