ABSTRACT OF PROMULGATION HISTORY

On December 16, 1985, the Commission Staff filed a petition to commence rulemaking proceedings for the revision of Rule 2.01(1) of the Rules and Regulations for the Government of Electric Utilities.

On August 29, 1986, the Commission entered an order granting Staff's petition of December 16, 1985 and initiating a proceeding for the purpose of promulgating a proposed amendment to Legislative Rule 2.01(1) of the Commission's Rules and Regulations for the Government of Electric Utilities. Adequate notice of the proposed rulemaking and copies of the proposed rules were provided to interested parties in accordance with the requirements of the August 29, 1986 Order and West Virginia Code §§29A-3-4 through 9. All interested parties were provided the opportunity to submit written comments to the Commission on or before September 29, 1986 at 12:00 noon.

Upon review of the comments submitted by various parties the Commission has determined that some of the proposed modifications should be adopted, and other changes made on the Commission's own initiative. Therefore, on March 30, 1987, the Commission adopted the rules hereinafter set forth as the Rules and Regulations for the Government of Electric Utilities as final rules to become effective sixty days after promulgation, in accordance with West Virginia Code §24-1-7.

FISCAL NOTE

This is a Fiscal Note issued pursuant to §§29A-3-4, 29A-3-5, 29A-3-4, 5 and 9 and West Virginia Code §24-1-7, relating to the Commission's General Order No. 184.6, In the Matter of the Revision of Rule 2.01(1) of the Commission's Rules and Regulations for the Government of Electric Utilities.

I. OBJECTIVES OF THE RULE

The objective of this proposed amendment is to bring the Commission's regulations for electric utility preservation of records up to date with the requirement of the National Association of Regulatory Commissioners, and to provide for uniformity in the multi-jurisdictional electric utilities' preservation of records.
