Proceeding on the Commission's Own Motion.

COMMISSION ORDER PROVIDING NOTICE OF PUBLIC COMMENT

On July 8, 1988, the Commission issued General Order No. 188.5 which promulgated as an emergency rule "Rules and Regulations for the Use and Consumption of Water by the Inhabitants and all Users, Regardless of Class of Service, During Times of Emergency and Periods of Temporary Inadequacy of Supply of Available Water".


On September 6, 1988, the Commission filed a Notice of Public Comment with the Secretary of State's Office concerning the aforesaid rule. It is the purpose of this order to provide further public notice of the opportunity to submit written comments.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that the Commission shall receive written public comments upon the merits of the rules adopted by General Order No. 188.5 on July 8, 1988, from any interested party on or before November 1, 1988, at 5:00 p.m., which shall be directed to: Howard M. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the aforesaid rules shall remain in effect until the further order of the Commission.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Executive Secretary serve a copy of this order on all water utilities subject to the Commission's jurisdiction and upon all other parties of interest by United States First Class Mail, and he is hereby authorized to provide such other notice as he may deem necessary and reasonable under the circumstances.
