Governing Emergency Telephone Service;

Dear Ms. Cooper:

On November 1, 2005 the Public Service Commission promulgated proposed emergency rules in response to House Bill 3208 passed during the 2005 legislative session. This legislation can be found at *West Virginia Code* § 24-6-6b. The statute made this particular rule-making subject to legislative rule review and authorized the Commission to issue emergency rules.

On November 29, 2005 the Commission promulgated a legislative rule-making of 150 CSR Series 25. The Commission's agency-approved rules were submitted April 10, 2006. Those rules were reported-out by the Legislative Rule-Making and Review Committee without any modifications.

On March 11, 2006 the West Virginia Legislature passed Senate Bill 728, effective July 1, 2006. Senate Bill 728 amended and reenacted *West Virginia Code* § 24-6-6b(b), necessitating an additional revision of 150 CSR Series 25. By a separate filing the Commission will submit a new emergency rule and new proposed legislative rule.

In order to avoid the confusion that would be caused by the Commission promulgating an additional set of rule-makings while the above-described rule-makings are pending, please allow this letter to serve as notice, pursuant to West Virginia Code § 29A-3-14, that the


