On June 30, 2006, the Public Service Commission requested emergency treatment of a legislative rule-making, 150 C.S.R. Series 31, *Rules Governing E911 Fees*. At that time, the Commission also filed 150 C.S.R. Series 31 as an exempt legislative rule-making.

Upon review, the Commission has decided to withdraw its request for emergency rulemaking treatment for this new series. See order issued 7/29/06, attached. Accordingly, please process 150 C.S.R. Series 31 only as an exempt legislative-rulemaking. The Commission reserves the right to request emergency status for Series 31 rules at a later date.
