The purpose in making these changes is to better delineate the classifications in which the greyhounds are placed as well as to facilitate the ranking or grading of the greyhounds based upon their performance for regular races and stake races. Further the patrons will be better able to recognize the grading and types of races on which they are wagering. Refining the criteria for grading is in the best interest of racing. The Racing Commission will have input when stake races are to be scheduled.
