Section *1.2* Historical Background

1.1 The governing boards previously responsible for higher education in West Virginia had substantially different policies concerning the naming of buildings or schools at the State institutions of higher education.

Section *1.3* Procedure

2.1 It will be the policy of the Board of Regents to establish an official name of a building or school at an institution upon recommendation of the President of the institution with the concurrence of his advisory board, provided, however, if it is proposed that the building or school be named for a person, such individual must have rendered distinguished educational or other service to the institution and must not have been employed at the institution during the three previous years. An exception may be made by the Board of Regents in the case of the gift of a building.

**§128-6-2. Historical Background.**

2.1. The governing boards previously responsible for higher education in West Virginia had substantially different policies concerning the naming of buildings or schools at the state institutions of higher education.

**§128-6-3. Procedure.**

3.1. It will be the policy of the Board of Trustees to establish an official name of a building or school at an institution upon recommendation of the president of the institution with the concurrence of his advisory board: **Provided, however,** That if it is proposed that the building or school be named for a person, such individual must have rendered distinguished educational or other service to the institution and must not have been employed at the institution during the three (3) previous years. An exception may be made by the Board of Trustees in the case of the gift of a building.
