POLICY REGARDING RETIREMENT
OF BOARD OF REGENTS' EMPLOYEES

*Section 2
Retirement
Dates*

- 2.1 BE IT RESOLVED, That all employees of the West Virginia Board of Regents as of January 1, 1979, and those employed subsequently shall be retired at the conclusion of the academic year or fiscal year contract period during which they reach their seventieth birthday and in no event later than the June 30 which coincides with or is next after their seventieth birthday.
- 2.2 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That normal retirement age is sixty-five.
- 2.3 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That tenured faculty shall be retired at the conclusion of the academic year or fiscal year contract period during which they reach their seventieth birthday. In the event such person shall reach age seventy in the middle of a semester or fiscal year, such person shall not be compelled to retire prior to the end of the semester or fiscal year: Provided, that in no event shall such retirement be postponed beyond six months after the date on which such person attained the age of seventy.
- 2.4 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That certain high-level executive or managerial employees as those terms are defined by relevant law and interpreted by the Board shall be retired at the conclusion of the academic year or fiscal contract period during which they reach their sixty-fifth birthday and in no event later than the June 30 which coincides with or is next after their sixty-fifth birthday.
