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A BILL to amend and reenact section thirty(seven)(four), article two, chapter sixty-four of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to registered for examiners of the board authorizing to promulgate regulations professional nurses policies, requirements and recommendations for accreditated programs of professional nursing; the criteria for evaluation and accreditation of professional nursing; the requirements for registration and licensure as a registered professional nurse; and the legal standards of nursing practice for the registered professional nurse.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section thirty(seven)(four), article two, chapter sixtyfour of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred
thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as
follows:

1 ARTICLE 2. EXECUTIVE AGENCY AUTHORIZATION TO PROMULGATE 2 LEGISLATIVE RULES.

\$64-2-30(7)(4). Board of examiners for registered professional nurses.

- (a) The legislative rules filed in the state register on the thirteenth day of September, one thousand nine hundred eighty-three, relating to the board of examiners for registered professional nurses (qualifications of graduates of foreign nursing schools for admission to the professional nurse licensing examination) are authorized.
- (b) The legislative rules filed in the state register on the twenty-eighth day of August, one thousand nine hundred eighty-five, relating to the board of examiners for registered professional nurses (the policies, requirements and recommendations for accreditated programs of professional nurses; the criteria for the evaluation and accreditation of professional nursing; the requirements for registration and licensure as a registered professional nurse; and the legal standards of nursing practice for the registered professional nurse; are authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the board of registered professional nurses to promulgate legislative rules relating to the policies, requirements and recommendations for accreditated programs of professional nursing; the criteria for the evaluation and accreditation of professional nursing; the requirements for registration and licensure as a registered professional nurse; and the legal standards of nursing practice for the registered professional nurse.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from the present law, and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.

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
