FILING OF CAMPAIGN FINANCIAL REPORTS**

**§153-9-1. General.**

1.1. Scope. -- This interpretive rule relates to the filing with the Secretary of State of the financial statements provided for in West Virginia Code sections five and five-a, article eight, chapter three.

1.2. Authority. -- W. Va. Code §3-1A-6, §3-8-5, §3-8-5a and §3-8-5b

1.3. Filing Date. -- October 25, 1985

1.4. Effective Date. -- October 25, 1985

**§153-9-2. Filing financial statements.**

Any person required under 2 U.S.C. §439 of the Federal Election Commission (FEC) to file a financial report and statement with the West Virginia Secretary of State shall not be required to also file the financial statements provided for in West Virginia Code sections five and five-a, article eight, chapter three. The FEC report when filed with the West Virginia Secretary of State under 2 U.S.C. §439 is interpreted as compliance with the filing requirements of West Virginia Code section five-b, article eight, chapter three in such cases.
