Proposed Rule: **Use of Digital Signatures, State Certification Authority and State Repository, 153CSR31**

The Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee recommends that the West Virginia Legislature:

1. Authorize the agency to promulgate the Legislative rule
 - (a) as originally filed
 - (b) as modified by the agency
2. Authorize the agency to promulgate part of the Legislative rule; a statement of reasons for such recommendation is attached.
3. Authorize the agency to promulgate the Legislative rule with certain amendments; amendments and a statement of reasons for such recommendation is attached.
4. Authorize the agency to promulgate the Legislative rule as modified with certain amendments; amendments and a statement of reasons for such recommendation is attached.
5. Recommends that the Legislative rule be withdrawn; a statement of reasons for such recommendation is attached.

If the first page of this form indicates that your agency has agreed to modify the proposed rule in accordance with a motion adopted by the Committee, your agency should consult with the Committee's counsel on the preparation of the modifications. By Monday, October 1, 2001, your agency must file 1 copy of your modified rule with the Secretary of State's office and 10 copies with the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee.

W.Va. Code §29A-3-12 requires that this Committee submit its report to the full Legislature by the Twentieth Day of the Regular Session, and by that time all bills of authorization must be ready for introduction. The date that you filed your modified rule in the Secretary of State's office must be included in the Bill of Authorization.

Please disregard this notice if you have already filed your final, modified rule. Committee rules state that a copy of this letter must be on file for each agency filing a rule.
