The West Virginia Solid Waste Management Board (SWMB) officially requests that its Proposed Legislative Rule 54CSR6, be withdrawn. The SWMB held a special meeting on Thursday, January 11, 2007 and by unanimous consent voted to withdraw this rule, as recommended by the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee.

The SWMB, in collaboration with the Department of Environmental Protection and the Public Service Commission, will be modifying language in this rule that would eliminate any duplicative oversight of commercial solid waste facilities operated by solid waste authorities. After this task is completed, the SWMB fully intends to re-file the modified rule.
