Dear Mr. Manchin:

On March 10, 1984, the West Virginia Legislature passed Com. Sub. for Senate Bill No. 425 and made it effective from passage.

This bill added section 64-2-11(1a)(11) to the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended. That section authorizes the State Tax Commissioner to amend and then promulgate the legislative rules filed in the State Register on January 5, 1984, relating to appraisal of property for periodic state-wide reappraisals for ad valorem property tax purposes.

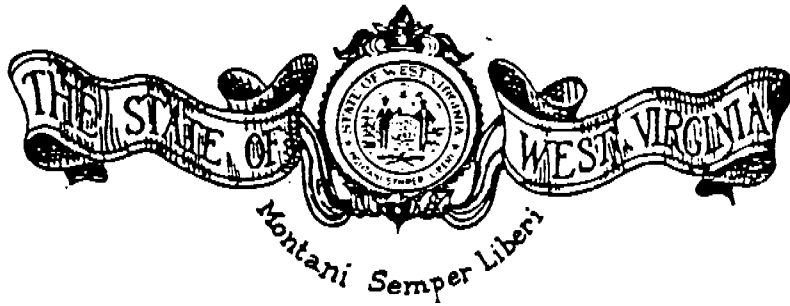
We have made the amendments required by W. Va. Code § 64-2-11(1a)(11) [1984]. With this letter, we submit for filing in the State Register two copies of the legislative rule promulgated in accordance with W. Va. Code § 64-2-11(1a)(11) [1984] and § 29A-3-13 [1983]. This legislative rule takes effect on April 12, 1984, thirty (30) days after its filing in the State Register, as provided in W. Va. Code § 29A-3-13(b) [1983].
